Focus: Strategic Prayer for Kashmir

Proposed dates: September/October 2026

Cost: R26 500 per person

(Includes: flights, transport costs, food costs and accommodation, and R1 500 non-refundable deposit. Excludes: visa fees)

Purpose of the Prayer Journeys: To pray for the nation of India – specifically for Kashmir, the most northern part of India. Kashmir is torn between India, Pakistan and China. It is a poor, populous and almost unreachable area high up in the Himalaya Mountains.

Tour leader: Michael, a young South African worker for God, now living in Delhi, India is experienced in the Indian culture and speaks Urdu fluently.

Who may go: Christian born again believers with an interest in prayer and a heart for the Muslim world and the nation of India. It is essential that team members should be healthy and very fit.
