Germany arise in the glory of God (Is 60:1)

Here is an African already living for 30+ years in Germany praying the blood of Jesus over the nation she loves (Lika Oloyede of ‘Global Intercession for Nations’).



Hear and pray her prophetic words:

- Let us raise a prayer altar for the nation of Germany;
- Have mercy over this nation --wash this nation from their sin -may they be washed by the blood of Jesus;
- Germany arise in the glory of God - Is 60:1;
- Father, take control of this nation – be the God of Germany and bring order – Is.33:22;
- From so much science and a social system caring for people - to a new total reliance on God;
- We speak to the young generation – know God and arise – let the Spirit of the LORD work in you!!

Let us pray

- Lord, is it possible that a small team coming from another continent thousands of kilometers away can plant revival seeds in Germany? We pray, make it possible. Let Germany arise and shine again for You. May we still experience this in our generation.
- O Lord, give us favour we pray, as we start preparing, renewing relationships with brothers and sisters in Germany and finding completely new partners with the same heart for You.
- What a wonderful challenge finding young people of all our tribes and nations who have heard your call and are willing to serve you, giving their everything to win Germany back for Christ.
- May we leave behind a fresh understanding of the power of prayer and ‘the power in the blood’, eg through regularly sharing communion in Germany.
- O Lord may this outreach stir hearts in South Africa, reminding a nation in deep thankfulness of the immeasurable gift of salvation that You brought us from Europe.
